## 3-on-3 Tournament Rules

- 1. Games will be played on a half-court.
  - a. If there is a turnover and the ball has touched the hoop after a shot was taken by the offensive team, the defensive team must return the ball outside of the 3-point line before they can score a basket.
- To begin, one player from each team will 'shoot for ball' from behind the 3-point line. Each player will shoot until they have made a basket and the other player misses.
- 3. Teams of up to 7 are allowed for substitution purposes.
- 4. Games will be played to 21, with field goals being worth 1 point, and 3-pointers worth 2 points. Free throws will count as 1 point.
  - a. The winning team must get to 21 and win by 2 points.
- 5. There will be a 30 minute time limit for each game. If at the end of 30 minutes and there is still no victor, the team with the most points will win.
  - a. In the event of a tie, there will be a sudden death, in which the first team to score wins. Rock, Paper, Scissors will determine which team gets the ball first in sudden death.
- 6. Fouls will be called by the players themselves, with a KAWnsas Fest representative onsite to settle any disputed calls.
- 7. This is a family-friendly, community driven event. Players who display poor sportsmanship are subject to being ejected from play. An ejected player is barred from further participation in the tournament and may be subject to a permanent ban from future KAWnsas Fest-sponsored recreation events.
  - a. Teams who have two or more players who are ejected will be disqualified from the tournament and will forfeit their entry fees.
